Gerritt & Tara Kenyon have been ministering in Panama for five years. As they have been sharing the gospel in the public high schools of Panama City through ethics and character presentations, an urgent need has emerged through altar-time conversations with students. An alarming number of students, primarily, though not exclusively, girls, have come to them ruined by the horror of sexual abuse. Through these altar times, the Holy Spirit has burdened the Kenyons to take action in the lives of these girls, mending these broken daughters.

In response, they have hosted an annual Girls-Only event called "ILUMINA" to address these taboo issues and facilitate healing through dynamic testimonies and the presentation of the gospel as their hope & future. They ministered to over 3,000 girls in 2014 and in their recent 2015 conference over 2,500 girls.



A country of only 3.5 million, nearly half are under 18 and live in the capital

El Refuge Urban Ministry Center, a youth-church and outreach center, will launch in Fall 2015 as a place where Panamanian students can find and develop their identity in Christ. The Kenyons will use every method available to reach the emerging generation.
